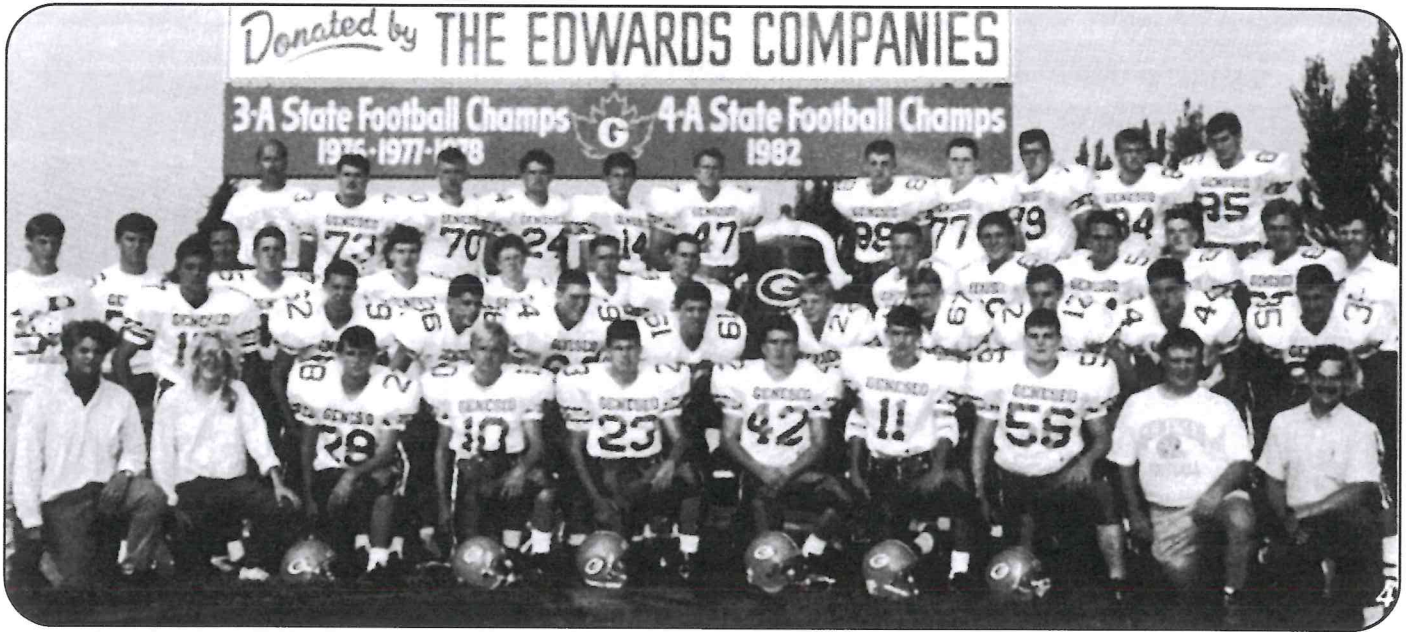

This team saw itself continually get better as the season unfolded. After a setback to a very good Cedar Falls team, the Green Machine cruised through the NCIC. The closest game was against Dixon 27-9. During the first round of the IHSA playoffs Geneseo dominated Metamora 34-7. They succeeded in round two against Peoria. In the quarterfinals, Geneseo defeated Rantoul by a staggering 45-15 score. This game sent Geneseo into the Semifinals against Carbondale. Yet again Geneseo beat their contenders. The final score was 34-21. Geneseo then prepared for the championship game against another storied program, top-rated Joliet Catholic and Mike Alstott. Geneseo fell just inches short on a two point conversion in the final moments, losing 21-20. That game is considered one of the all-time greatest in IHSA Championship game history.
