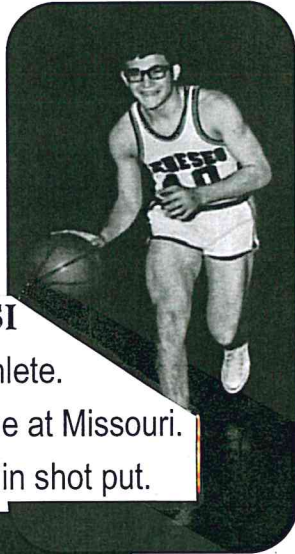


For much of his life, GHS Athletic Hall of Famer Bob Orsi was known by Geneseo residents as a kind-spirited, community-minded friend who brought the Geneseo Park District to a level that continues to be revered as one of excellence. Throughout his high school football career he was a feared, fierce and relentless competitor at the linebacker position. An All-American senior season capped off a career in which Orsi never tasted a football defeat. Also, in his senior year he was selected as captain of the All-State team.

Orsi went on to the University of Missouri to suit up for the Tigers. While at Columbia Orsi was a three-time varsity letter winner.

Orsi also is the former record-holder in the shot put and was a starting guard on the GHS basketball team.

Orsi returned to his hometown as Director of the Geneseo Park District for 32 years and is a staple in the stands at Green Machine games.
